For 2022, we are having 10 art vendors each day | 5 non-profits each day | and 3 Food Vendors each day. Vendors are required to submit 2 photographs of their set up/art with this application to the attention of Melissa Cooperman, Community Arts Coordinator at mcooperman@dorchesterarts.org to be reviewed by the Festival Committee. All items must be 100% artisan crafted & domestic made goods for the Art Vendors.

Booth spaces are 10'x10'. The two-day event will go on rain or shine and there will be no refunds due to inclement weather.

The Festival area will have an Art Barn for visiting Chalk Artists demonstrating their work and a Music Stage with performers throughout the two-day event.

This is the first year for this Festival and has the support of Dorchester County and the Hoopers Island community. The hope is to make this an annual Chalk Arts destination to celebrate the medium. This event will be promoted and advertised on social media, Dorchester County Tourism, Radio, and other promotional outlets both online and printed around the county. Hoopers Island First Chalk Arts Festival | Creating Healing Waves one Chalk Line at a Time runs from 10 am to 4 pm on Saturday, November 5th and Sunday, November 6th. This is a 2-day event where attendees will be able to see Chalk Art demonstrations from artists joining us from around the country to complete over the course of this festival.

Art and Not-for-profit booth can begin set up at 7 am on November 5th and 6th. Booths must be set up and ready to go by 9:30 am on each day registered to participate. Vendors are responsible for the setup and tear down of booths and **MUST** have secured weights for their tents. There are no refunds/no rain checks for vendors.

Food vendors must provide all food and heating equipment, but will be given electricity if needed. There is a fixed fee and a percentage of sales of 5% from each day payable to Dorchester Center for the Arts. All food carts must submit this application along with a copy of the Health Department form to reserve your space at the Festival. Mail Health forms 2 weeks before the event to Dorchester County Health Department | Division of Environmental Health | 3 Cedar Street, Cambridge, MD 21613. Their PH: 410-228-1167 & FX: 410-901-8192. We will have limited and non-duplicated food vendors to join us at this festival to encourage a positive experience. This is a free and non-alcoholic event.
